

Instructions

Consult the Material Safety Data Sheet(s) on file that pertain to the liquids that spilled.

- 1. Call for assistance if necessary
- 2. Put on the gloves and goggles
- 3. Place socks around the area of the spill to prevent persons from tracking through the spilled material and to prevent the spreading of the spill
- 4. Put the grey pads from the kit around the spill and/or inside the contained area to start the absorption process.
- 5. Add pads as needed to absorb the spill. When the pads are fully saturated, they will appear dark and wet.
- Sweep or scoop up the contaminated absorbent with the enclosed shuffle and place it into the disposal bags or wheelie bin directly
- 7. Remove the last remaining liquid from the floor by pouring lose absorbent from the large bag on the spill
- Sweep up the loose absorbent with the enclosed broom and shuffle and put it in the waste bags or wheelie bin
- If needed, the surface can be cleaned with the cleaning product in the small yellow bottle. This cleaning product can be diluted with water up to 1:50.
- 10. Make selfadhesive label(s), identifying the waste as Waste Oil containing XYZ Chemical, and attach to the container and/or waste bags
- 11. Dispose of the waste according to local regulations.
